

## **LESSON 3 – EXPLORE**

## **BEFORE STARTING:**

- IDENTIFY A PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR **DOCUMENTS IN CLASS** TO TAKE PHOTOS AND MAKE NOTES ON DECISIONS TAKEN
- DOCUMENT THE STAGES OF THE RESEARCH ON THE **ASOC WALL**
- OPTIONAL: IF NOT DONE ALREADY, ORGANISE AN APPEARANCE IN CLASS BY AN EXPERT ON THE CHOSEN TOPIC (E.G. ENVIRONMENT, TRANSPORT, ETC.) OR DATA ANALYSIS.

## **IN CLASS**

- 2. Document the stages of the research on the ASOC WALL
- 3. Have Report 3 template to hand, which can guide compiling and publication, by the prescribed deadline.

be structured and made available to the community in such a way that

anyone can read it and potentially continue the research with you and report

any critical issues, ideas and proposals on its implementation to the

administration

• Collect information directly in the territory, starting from the data

analysed in class

• Interview the project's key people: implementing bodies, citizens,

organisations involved

• Produce images, video material and geo-reference the projects in the

territory

• Publish a monitoring report on Monithon.it
