



## Brief description of civic monitoring research

The European Union has provided the municipality of Bisceglie with almost one and a half million euros in order to finance the enhancement of the Cultural Heritage through the improvement of the Bisceglie library system. In the first place the goal was the modernization of the already existing municipal library in the former monastery complex Holy Cross, expanded then to the Swabian Angevin castle, Garibaldi theater, school and ecclesiastical libraries and Universo Salute (former Casa Divina Provvidenza) but especially to the opening of a new library at Villa Angelica, in the s.Andrew area.
