We selected the municipality of Sirmione (BS) by investigating the "Energy" item, where we found our theme: "Interventions to improve the energy efficiency of public lighting systems in the municipality of Sirmione". We chose this theme because the amount of expenditure foreseen for the project seemed to us to be high. The intervention also took place in the municipality of Sirmione using mostly money from the European Union and not from the municipality itself.
